Decision with Statement of Reasons of the First-tier Tribunal for Scotland (Housing and Property Chamber) under Section 16 of the Housing (Scotland) Act 2014

**Decision (in absence of the Respondents)** 

The First-tier Tribunal for Scotland (Housing and Property Chamber) ("the Tribunal") determined that

Background

This is an application for an order for payment in relation to rent allegedly owed by the Respondents in relation to the Property. It called for a hearing at 2pm on 13 September 2018. The Applicant was represented by Mr McDermott of Friels Solicitors. The Respondents were not present or represented.

Findings in Fact

The Property was let to the Respondents in terms of a short assured tenancy dated 27 June 2016 and commencing on that date. In terms of that tenancy, rent of £500 was due on the twenty-seventh of each month. The Respondents failed to make any payment on 27 July 2016 and have made no payment since. As at 27 April 2018, £11,000 was outstanding.

## Reasons for Decision

The sum requested being due to the Applicants by the Respondents, order for payment of that sum should be granted.

Decision

Order made for payment of the sum of £11,000 (ELEVEN THOUSAND POUNDS STERLING) by the Respondents to the Applicant.

## Right of Appeal

In terms of Section 46 of the Tribunal (Scotland) Act 2014, a party aggrieved by the decision of the Tribunal may appeal to the Upper Tribunal for Scotland on a point of law only. Before an appeal can be made to the Upper Tribunal, the party must first seek permission to appeal from the First-tier Tribunal. That party must seek permission to appeal within 30 days of the date the decision was sent to them.
