

Inspection Notes

- 1. The Tribunal noted the presence of a current Gas Safety Certificate during its inspection of the Property.
- 2. The Tribunal noted the presence of smoke alarms in the Living room, Hallway and Upper Landing, together with a heat sensor in the Kitchen. These were tested, and it was noted that each unit was fully functioning and interconnected. Photographs 11,12 & 13 above refer.
- 3. It was noted by the Tribunal that the door from the Living room leading to the Balcony was now fully functioning, and was capable of being locked.
- 4. The Tribunal also noted in the Living Room that the window unit had been repaired, and was now fully functioning and lockable. Photograph 2 above refers.
- 5. The Tribunal noted that the broken floorboard in Bedroom 2 had now been repaired.
- 6. It was noted by the Tribunal that replacement UPVC window units had been installed in Bedrooms 1 and 2. Photographs 9 & 10 above refer.
- 7. The Tribunal was advised by the Applicant that a central heating engineer had yet to inspect the property.
