The Tribunal certifies that the Property Factor Enforcement Order dated 31 January 2025 has been complied with for the reasons set out in its decision of even date.

Terms of the Property Factor Enforcement Order (PFEO):

The Property Factor is required to pay the sum of £50 to the Homeowner within thirty days of the PFEO being made.

Appeals

A homeowner or property factor aggrieved by the decision of the Tribunal may appeal to the Upper Tribunal for Scotland on a point of law only. Before an appeal can be made to the Upper Tribunal, the party must first seek permission to appeal from the First-tier Tribunal. That party must seek permission to appeal within 30 days of the date the decision was sent to them.
