Certificate of Compliance with Property Factor Enforcement Order dated 15 May 2025.

The Tribunal determines that the said Property Factor Enforcement Order has been complied with.

Terms of the Property Factor Enforcement Order (PFEО):

The Tribunal required the Respondent to pay the sum of ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY POUNDS (£150) to the Homeowner within thirty days of the service on it of the final PFEО in terms of Section 19 (3) of the 2011 Act.

Reason for Decision

The Applicant confirmed that the Respondent had paid the sum of £150 to her.

Appeals

A homeowner or property factor aggrieved by the decision of the Tribunal may appeal to the Upper Tribunal for Scotland on a point of law only. Before an appeal can be made to the Upper Tribunal, the party must first seek permission to appeal from the First-tier Tribunal. That party must seek permission to appeal within 30 days of the date the decision was sent to them.
