Evidence of water ingress, mould and high moisture readings were noted about 1 metre from the corner of the lounge.





A corner section of the original lath and plaster ceiling had collapsed due to water ingress from common roof. Low moisture readings were noted at this site. Evidence of cracking and water staining to the ceiling and decorative cornicing was evident.


Bathroom/shower room



Evidence of peeling paint within shower cubicle.




Low moisture readings noted within shower cubicle.





The walls and ceiling within the shower room do not appear to be plasterboard. This may be causing the paint to peel from the surface.



A small section of mould was noted on the bathroom/ shower room ceiling, normal moisture readings noted.
