The Tribunal determines that the said Property Factor Enforcement Order dated 5 February 2025 has been complied with.

Terms of the Property Factor Enforcement Order (PFEO):

The Property Factor is required to pay compensation of £1500 to the Homeowner.

Reason for Decision

The Homeowner confirmed on 4 August 2025 that the sum of £1500 had been paid to her.

Appeals

A homeowner or property factor aggrieved by the decision of the Tribunal may appeal to the Upper Tribunal for Scotland on a point of law only. Before an appeal can be made to the Upper Tribunal, the party must first seek permission to appeal from the First-tier Tribunal. That party must seek permission to appeal within 30 days of the date the decision was sent to them.
