



**Rejection of Application: Notification of decision under Section 28A(3) of the Housing (Scotland) Act 2006 (“The Act”)**

As the member asked to decide on the application for access by the landlord to the property, detailed above, I am writing to advise of that decision.

The Landlord’s application consists of all documents received between 1 September 2025 and 9 February 2026 and I have concluded that no further information is required before a decision can be made. After considering the application, taking into account the terms of Section 28A(3) of the Act, I have decided that the application should be rejected.

The grounds for rejection are listed in Section 55(1)(a-e) of the regulations. I have decided this application should be rejected on the following ground:

c) the member has good reason to believe that it would not be appropriate to assist either the landlord or any person the landlord intends to authorise to enter the house, or both, to gain entry to the house;

The reason for rejection under this ground is that the landlord failed to respond to correspondence from the Tribunal seeking further information or an amended application.

**In terms of Section 28A(8) of the Act this decision of the member is final.**
