Summary of Discussion

- 1. The Applicant did not attend the Case Management Discussion but was represented by Jennifer Kent of Perth & Kinross Council;
- 2. The Respondent did not attend the Case Management Discussion;
- 3. The Applicant's representative advised the Tribunal that the Respondent had vacated the Property on or before 3 April 2019 and the keys had been returned;
- 4. The Applicant's representative considered that an order for eviction was no longer necessary;
- 5. In the circumstances the Tribunal dismissed the Application for an order for eviction on the basis that it was no longer necessary.

Outcome

The Tribunal dismissed the application as it was no longer insisted upon and an order was unnecessary.
