Decision with Statement of Reasons of the First-tier Tribunal for Scotland (Housing and Property Chamber) under Section 16 of the Housing (Scotland) Act 2014

Decision (in absence of the Respondent)
The First-tier Tribunal for Scotland (Housing and Property Chamber) ("the Tribunal") determined that the Respondents are Ordered to make a payment of Two Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty Pounds $(£ 2,750)$ to the Applicant

## Background

The parties entered into a private residential tenancy agreement in respect of the property at Flat $1 / 19$ Cleveland Crescent Glasgow G12 OPB which commenced on 25 July 2018. The monthly rental payments were $£ 950$ per calendar month.

The Respondents have vacated the property. The application is brought in respect of unpaid rent accrued prior to their vacation.

Findings in Fact
The monthly rental payments of $£ 950$ were not paid after August 2018. As at the date of application 3 months rent was outstanding, totalling $£ 2,850$. The Respondents have failed or delayed making payment of such sums.

Reasons for Decision
The contractual residential tenancy legally obliges the Respondents to make the stated rental payments. They have not done so. The Applicant is entitled to recover these sums.

## Right of Appeal

In terms of Section 46 of the Tribunal (Scotland) Act 2014, a party aggrieved by the decision of the Tribunal may appeal to the Upper Tribunal for Scotland on a point of law only. Before an appeal can be made to the Upper Tribunal, the party must first seek permission to appeal from the First-tier Tribunal. That party must seek permission to appeal within 30 days of the date the decision was sent to them.
