DECISION

The Tribunal has decided to issue a Property Factor Enforcement Order ("PFEO"). The terms of the PFEO are stated below.

REASONS FOR DECISION

No correspondence has been received from the parties in the period since the issue of our Decision and Proposed PFEO dated 26 April 2017. We are therefore of the

view that a PFEO should be issued in accordance with the original proposal.

PROPERTY FACTOR ENFORCEMENT ORDER

The Tribunal hereby makes the following Property Factor Enforcement Order

("PFEO"):

Within 31 days of the date of the communication to the Respondent of this Property

Factor Enforcement Order, the Respondent must:

1 Pay to the Applicant the sum of £200.

2 Confirm in writing to the office of the Tribunal that step 1 above has been

carried out.

Failure to comply with a property factor enforcement order may have serious

consequences and may constitute an offence.

APPEALS

In terms of section 46 of the Tribunals (Scotland) Act 2014, a party aggrieved by the decision of the Tribunal may appeal to the Upper Tribunal for Scotland on a point of

law only. Before an appeal can be made to the Upper Tribunal, the party must first seek permission to appeal from the First-tier Tribunal. That party must seek

permission to appeal within 30 days of the date the decision was sent to them.
