The Tribunal determines that the said Property Factor Enforcement Order has been complied with.

Terms of the Property Factor Enforcement Order (PFEO):

Within fourteen days of service of the Property Factor Enforcement Order, the property factor will pay the sum of £200 to the homeowner as compensation.

Reason for Decision

The property factor paid the sum of £200 to the homeowner and this was confirmed by the Homeowner in a letter to the Tribunal dated 4th October 2018

Appeals

A homeowner or property factor aggrieved by the decision of the Tribunal may appeal to the Upper Tribunal for Scotland on a point of law only. Before an appeal can be made to the Upper Tribunal, the party must first seek permission to appeal from the First-tier Tribunal. That party must seek permission to appeal within 30 days of the date the decision was sent to them.
