The First-tier tribunal for Scotland (Housing and Property Chamber) ('the tribunal') having determined on 3 January 2017 that the **Repairing Standard Enforcement Order** relative to the house served on 12 January 2017 should be varied, the said **Repairing Standard Enforcement Order** is hereby varied with effect from the date of service of this Notice in the following respects:-

1. The period allowed for the completion of the work required by the order is extended for a further two months.

Subsection 25(3) of the Housing (Scotland) Act 2006 does apply in this case.

A landlord, tenant or third party applicant aggrieved by the decision of the tribunal may appeal to the Upper Tribunal for Scotland on a point of law only. Before an appeal can be made to the Upper Tribunal, the party must first seek permission to appeal from the First-tier Tribunal. That party must seek permission to appeal within 30 days of the date the decision was sent to them.

Where such an appeal is made, the effect of the decision and of any order is suspended until the appeal is abandoned or finally determined by the Upper

Tribunal, and where the appeal is abandoned or finally determined by upholding the decision, the decision and any order will be treated as having effect from the day on which the appeal is abandoned or so determined.
