STATEMENT OF DECISION OF THE PRIVATE RENTED HOUSING COMMITTEE UNDER SECTION 26(1) OF THE HOUSING (SCOTLAND) ACT 2006

DECISION

The Private Rented Housing Committee ("the Committee"), having made such enquiries as is fit for the purposes of determining whether the Landlord has complied with the Repairing Standard Enforcement Order (hereinafter referred to as "the RSEO") in relation to the house concerned, and taking account of the findings of the surveyor member following a re-inspection of the house, the Committee considered that the Landlord had satisfactorily completed the works detailed in the RSEO and decided to issue a certificate of completion of works in terms of Section 60 of the Act.

Background

1. Reference is made to the Determination of the Committee dated 26 November 2012 which decided that the Landlord had failed to comply with the duty imposed by Section 14(1) (b) of the Act and to the RSEO made by the Committee and signed on 10 December 2012 which required the Landlord to carry out works as specified in the RSEO ("the works"). The said works to be carried out and completed within a period of 42 days from the date of service of the Notice of the RSEO.

2. Following upon expiry of the timescale for completion of works specified in the RSEO, the surveyor member re-inspected the house on 28 January 2013 and confirmed that the works specified in the RSEO have been satisfactorily completed and decided that it is appropriate to issue a Certificate of Completion in terms of Section 60 of the Act. The members of the Committee were unanimous in their decision.
