

## Statement of facts and reasons for

# Decision to grant Certificate of completion of work Under section 60 of the Housing (Scotland) Act 2006

## PRHP REFERENCE KA19/42/08

In connection with Property at S.V.G.C.A. Cottage, Culzean Castle and Country Park, Maybole, Ayrshire KA19 8JX (hereinafter referred to as "the house")

## **PARTIES**

Mr. Krishman Moodley, S.V.G.C.A. Cottage, Culzean Castle and Country Park, Maybole, Ayrshire KA19 8JX ("the Tenant")

The Scottish Veterans' Garden City Association (Inc.), having their registered office at New Haig House, Logie Green Road, Edinburgh EH7 4HQ ("the Landlord")

## Statement of facts and reasons.

- 1. The surveyor member of the Private Rented Housing Committee reinspected the property on the morning of 21 July 2009 in order to ascertain whether the work required by the Repairing Standard Enforcement Order served on 17 December 2008 had been completed. The Tenant and the Landlord's agent, Mr Kennedy, were present at the re-inspection.
- 2. The Committee noted that the items (a) to (h) inclusive detailed in the said Repairing Standard Enforcement Order had been completed as required and damage caused thereby has been made good. It was noted that the Landlord's agent indicated that any snagging faults caused by the extensive works would be rectified. The Committee is satisfied that all works required by the RSEO have been satisfactorily carried out. Accordingly, the Committee decided to grant a Certificate of Completion.

A landlord or a tenant aggrieved by this decision of the Private Rented Housing Committee may appeal to the Sheriff by summary application within 21 days of being notified of that decision.

Where such an appeal is made, the effect of the decision and the Certificate is suspended until the appeal is abandoned or finally determined. Where the appeal is abandoned or finally determined by confirming the decision, the decision and the Certificate are to be treated as having effect from the day on which the appeal is abandoned or so determined.
